

## **Blue and Gold Scout Cake Contest**

Every Cub Scout is encouraged to enter a cake in the cake decorating contest! Each scout may bake a cake on their own or with the help of a trusted adult or friend who does not typically bake.

The rules are simple:

1. The main part of the cake must be cake/brownie/cookie or other home-baked good. No store-bought cakes. You may use boxed cake mixes, icing mixes or pre-made icing and decorations but you must mix and decorate your own cake.
2. Most decorations or special effects on the cake must be edible. Please watch for choking hazards.
3. Do not put scout names on the cakes. Each cake will be assigned a number when checked-in.
4. The cake must be baked and decorated by the scout. They may enlist the help of a trusted adult family member or friend.
5. EVERY SCOUT TEAM MUST ALSO CLEAN THE KITCHEN WHEN THEY'RE DONE!
6. Bring your own serving utensils marked with your name for serving your cake.

***Cake check-in will take place from 6:00 – 6:20PM on the day of the Blue and Gold.***
